

Dear speakers of poster presentations.

Following this [LINK](#), you can download the template for preparing your poster. The template is provided in several formats. Please use one of these files. In addition, the download also includes an example of a poster to give you an idea of how a poster presentation can look like. Please follow the instructions given in this example. The text on the poster must be in English. The use of the template is optional. But use an A0 page format in portrait mode (max. height = 1189 mm = 46.8 inches; max. width = 841 mm = 33.1 inches).

The poster presentation takes place in two steps:

1. At the end of one of the sub-sessions (i.e., after the oral presentations), you have time to show your PRINTED poster to the participants of this sub-session. The printed poster must be installed in the session room BEFORE THE SESSION STARTS and must be dismantled BEFORE THE NEXT SESSION STARTS by yourself. Please bring the printed poster to the congress venue on time. The congress organizer provides the tape for the installation and instructions on site. The size of the printed poster is limited to A0 in portrait mode. Note that you must bring the poster yourself to Salzburg.
2. In addition, there will be a room with several large screens where you can show your poster to interested participants at any time you and the participants want to (if one display is free). Thus, you need to provide us also the digital version of your poster (in the PDF format). In September, we will send you a link with which you can upload your digital poster to the congress server. To allow interested participants to contact you (e.g., for the arrangement of a discussion about your poster), provide your contact details on the poster (e.g., email address, WhatsApp number).

Please upload the digital version of your poster (**PDF format**) to our server until **October 1st, 2023**, latest: [LINK](#) (Attention: Oral presentation speakers receive a different link! Don't mix up the links if you have an oral and a poster presentation).

When preparing the digital version of your poster, please consider reducing the resolution of embedded images to 300 dpi. Otherwise, the PDF file becomes large, and it takes longer to load and handle the file (when you show your poster to interested participants on the screen). The maximum size of the poster is A0 in portrait mode.

Please use this filename for your PDF file: **TXX\_DD\_TTTT\_ID\_vX**

- TXX: The session ID (e.g., T14).

- DD: The day of your presentation. **11** for October 11th (Wednesday), **12** for October 12th (Thursday), and **13** for October 13th (Friday).
- TTTT: The starting time of your presentation. E.g., 1400 for 02:00 p.m., or 0900 for 09:00 a.m.
- ID: The ID of your contribution (e.g., 1100).
- vX: The version of your presentation. Start with 0: **v0**.

**And use this name also for the field "Ihr Name" on the server upload page.** This helps us to distribute your file efficiently.
