



Common causes include misaligned tracks, debris or obstructions in the track, issues with rollers or hinges, tension problems with springs, and incorrect sensor alignment.

How can I identify if track misalignment is causing the door jam?

Inspect the tracks for any visible gaps between them and the door. Check for uneven wear marks on the track or unusual noises when operating the door. Use a level to ensure tracks are plumb.

What steps should be taken if a jam is caused by debris in the track?

Clear any visible debris from the tracks using a damp cloth or vacuum. Ensure that no objects are obstructing the path of rollers. Regularly clean and lubricate tracks to prevent future jams.

How do I address roller and hinge issues to resolve a jam?

Examine rollers for signs of wear or damage; replace if necessary. Tighten any loose hinges and ensure they allow smooth movement of panels. Lubricate moving parts with appropriate garage door lubricant.

What adjustments can be made if spring tension is contributing to door jams?
